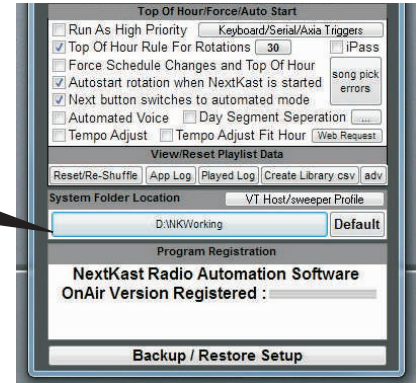


Setup for Shared Network or Cloud Drive

Nextkast can share a network Folder or Local Folder as its system folder location. This allows multiple Nextkast instances to work on the same music library, play list, configuration and voice tracking.

Setup Instructions

1. Create the Folder that will become the system drive on the Local computer. This can be either a Cloud Drive(Google drive, DropBox or Others) local sync folder or a shared network Folder on your internal network.(note DO NOT set cloud drive system to stream mode, it needs to operate in mirror mode, syncing files locally)
2. Select the location of the shared folder as shown on illustration to the right from the settings window in Nextkast.
3. For each nextkast system set up the network folder or cloud folder and repeat step 2. Each time a system folder location is changed, it requires a nextkast restart.
4. If you are migrating an existing setup to the cloud or network folder make sure to copy all the contents of the nextkast directory of the Playout System into the new folder location
5. Please note in case of a shared network folder the main playout computer should be the one sharing that folder.
